

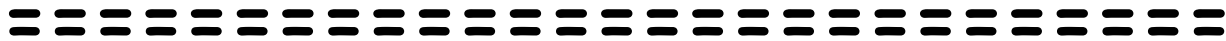

## Three Bean Salad

1 lb. fresh green beans	Dressing:	
1 lb. fresh yellow beans.	1/2 cup salad oil	1/2 tsp. paprika
15 oz. can kidney beans	1/2 cup white vinegar	1/4 tsp. dry mustard
1 green pepper	6 Tbsp. sugar	1/8 tsp. cayenne
1 red pepper	1 tsp. salt	
1 large Spanish onion	1/4 tsp pepper	
1/2 cup sliced water chestnuts		

For dressing, warm oil and vinegar in microwave and add other ingredients, mixing to dissolve.

Cut beans into short lengths and cook in a little salted water until tender crisp. Drain well. (Canned or frozen beans may be substituted.) Place in large bowl.

Drain and rinse kidney beans and add to bowl.

Pour warm dressing over beans, mixing well.

Quarter peppers and cut into thin slices. Slice onions paper thin. Combine with drained water chestnuts. Mix into bean mixture and refrigerate for at least 6 hours, mixing a couple of times to expose all ingredients to the dressing.
